Since 1941, the USO of Northern Ohio has served as a private, civilian 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization that receives no direct government funding, but relies solely on the generosity of corporations, organizations, and the American people.

The USO of Northern Ohio touches the lives of nearly 45,000 Active Duty, Guard and Reserve military and their families throughout our 29 county region. For over 70 years the USO of Northern Ohio has provided morale, recreation and social services to US Armed Forces personnel and their families through our programs and services. USO Center facilities are located in the Military Entrance Processing Station (MEPS), Cleveland Hopkins Airport, the NOSC in Toledo, and program processing center in Massillon. Together, our network of hundreds of volunteers donates nearly 20,000 hours of service annually in honor of our brave men and women.

The USO is chartered by Congress as a non-profit organization. It is not part of the U.S. government, but is recognized by the Department of Defense, Congress and President of the United States, who serves as Honorary Chairman of the USO.

When he graduated Joongang University, he was hand-picked to teach the Korean Green Berets hand-to-hand combat for 3 years.

PeaceKorps Sparring Team is for those who are Red and Black Freshman and above who have this kind of self-control. If you are interested in a challenging workout, specifically catered to the demanding and dynamic aspect of Taekwondo sparring, this is the team for you. Please speak with your main instructor if you are interested in this program.

Leadership Team (Instructor Team)

We are incredibly lucky to have Grandmaster Kim, a 9th Degree Black Belt in Taekwondo, as our primary instructor. He is assisted by a select group of certified instructors who are students themselves and know how to help because they've been through the requirements.



Grandmaster Kim teaches our Leadership Team every week, so every instructor is taught how to instruct in character fitness, philosophy and technique. This system gives our instructors a unique ability to work together toward the common goal of educating our students. We are focused, trained and ready!

Demo Team

Our Peacemakers Demo Team is a highly sought after group, meeting once or twice a week, preparing for demonstrations and learning accelerated techniques in order to perform at the highest level. This is an all encompassing martial art with a large emphasis on self-defense skills.

must be at least 10 years old

Our Kumdo curriculum represents Grandmaster Kim's dedication to giving us the best martial arts programs from the original source.

Grandmaster Kim sought the highest authorities in the field and was one of the first to bring Korean Swordsmanship to America. Yudo is the Korean Martial Art of throwing, grappling and using someone's attack against them. It is an excellent counterbalance to Taekwondo since all the techniques involve being close or grappling on the floor. A martial artist with a Yudo and Taekwondo background would have a keen awareness of movement, plus would have incredible humility. It takes a humble heart to train in Yudo properly.
